

Biohazard Clean-Up Guide for End Users

We have created this user guide to help families through the difficult time of dealing with a biohazardous situation. We encourage all coroners, law enforcement and funeral homes to use this as a guide to assist those in need of specialty clean-up services.

INSURANCE: What many people do not realize is that most biohazard clean-up services are covered by their homeowners or business insurance. With both, residential and commercial clean-ups, most insurance companies will provide payment for our services minus the deductible amount.

We always encourage people to use insurance to pay for a clean-up. Oftentimes, there is restoration that needs performed after we remove the biohazard and damaged material. Insurance will also pay for drywall repair, repainting, and flooring replacement.

Generally, a biohazard clean-up is only half the cost, while the other half is the repair. If the property has a mortgage, there is always insurance on the property. The mortgage holder always knows the insurance company that provides the coverage on a home or business.

CAUSE OF DEATH DOES NOT MATTER: The cause of the clean-up typically does not matter. Whether it be a homicide, suicide, decomposition or unattended death, generally all biohazard clean-up situations are covered by insurance.

CLAIM NUMBER: We need a claim number from the insurance company. If needed, we can help guide families in the right direction to receive a claim number. A claim number provides proof of insurance and authorization to perform a clean-up.

DOCUMENTATION: We take pre clean-up and post clean-up pictures to provide the insurance adjuster in the event they do not want to come on site or to avoid delay in clean-up. All materials, supplies and hours are tracked right down to the rubber glove. This helps us provide an exact and accurate cost to the insurance company.
